VILLAGE 2 SWIM AND TENNIS CLUB - RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Members current badge <u>must</u> be scanned each time they enter the club. Should you leave and re-enter, you must scan badge or check in again. Membership badges are non-transferable and a \$5.00 fee will be charged for replacement badges.
- 2. When guests are permitted (mid-season), members may bring guests for a fee and must sign all guests in before entering the club. No guests prior to this date no exceptions. Each membership is allowed a maximum of two (2) guests per household per day without prior authorization from club office. Guests must enter club with the pool member. Guests cannot enter club on their own and may only remain at club with member. Members are responsible for their guests at all times. Management reserves the right to refuse guests for any reason and/or to limit the number of times a guest may visit the club. We may also limit guest privileges for members who bring an excessive number of guests or abuse the ability to bring guests to the club (continually bringing same individual(s) without prior club authorization or failure to comply with policy). A guest may come a maximum of five (5) times per season (excludes immediate family members of same household).
- 3. No entering a pool or swimming unless a lifeguard is on duty.
- 4. No running in pool area. No consuming food or drink while in pools.
- 5. No splashing, dunking, or pushing other swimmers into the pools.
- 6. Rafts, tubes, other inflatables and ball playing allowed when pool conditions permit, <u>at the lifeguard's discretion</u>. Each guard is in charge of his or her pool. Inflatable safety devices permitted at all times.
- 7. Swimsuits only no cutoffs or clothes permitted.
- 8. Parents must be responsible for their children. CHILDREN AGE 6 AND UNDER MUST BE <u>WITH</u> THEIR PARENT / GUARDIAN AND SUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES, <u>INCLUDING THE BATHROOMS</u>, <u>SNACKBAR AND PLAYGROUND AREA</u>.
- 9. All children 12 years of age and under must be accompanied by an adult while on club premises and must pass a deep water test to use the diving boards or swim in deep water. A band will be issued when the deep water test is passed and must be worn at all times in order to use boards or swim in deep water. If the band is lost, a replacement band may be obtained for \$5.00 only once, and the child may need to take the swim test again. Swimming tests will only be given during designated hours at 11AM, 1 PM, 3 PM and 5 PM daily. Lifeguards reserve the right to suspend swimming tests at any time, if it infringes on their ability to safely guard their pools. Lifeguards also reserve the right to require a swimmer to take the swim test again, if they feel such is necessary to ensure the swimmer's safety.
- 10. Children over 12 years of age <u>may</u> be required to take the deep water swim test if a lifeguard or manager deems necessary, in order to enter the club without being accompanied by an adult. We reserve the right to ask any member or guest to perform the swim test at any time to ensure the safety of all members and their guests.
- 11. Glass bottles, containers are absolutely <u>not permitted</u> on club grounds. Pool employees reserve right to inspect all coolers / containers upon entrance to the club and may dispose of items.
- 12. You must use litter and recycling containers. Please clean up your area when leaving the club each day.
- 13. Swimmers may not swim in diving areas.
- 14. All dives must be forward facing and begin on the board. No running from behind the board and leaping onto it. One bounce only on diving boards.
- 15. One person on the diving board at a time. Be sure that the diver ahead has cleared the area before diving.
- 16. The lap pool is reserved for lap swimming only. Please limit your time to 30 minutes on weekends or while others are waiting. A sign in board will be implemented for use of the lap lanes at busy times.

- 17. <u>Babies must wear diapers AND secured rubber pants at all times to prevent contamination to the pools.</u> <u>Swim diapers alone are not acceptable.</u> This regulation is required by the Bucks County Department of Health. *avail for purchase
- 18. No lengthy talking or distracting lifeguards while on duty, as their focus must remain on pools.
- 19. No arguing with any pool staff member at any time, especially lifeguards. Concerns or problems should be addressed to management or in writing. Lifeguards have authority to warn members and guests (including children) for violations of rules and expel them for the day for failure to heed warnings. If patron becomes a continual problem for lifeguard staff, management reserves the right to expel from club for remainder of season.
- 20. No lewd or excessive public displays of affection.
- 21. No cigar / pipe smoking. Smoking of cigarettes is permitted in designated area ONLY. Please be courteous of others and dispose of cigarette butts in the proper containers. If found throwing butts on grounds, you will be asked to leave the club.
- 22. Tennis courts are for tennis / pickleball playing ONLY. Dogs, skateboards, bikes, etc. strictly prohibited. Use of the courts is on a first-come, first served basis no reservations or sign up necessary, however, we ask that you please be courteous and limit your time when others are waiting. All players must be members with a current badge or have signed in and paid as a guest of a member in order to use the courts. Proper tennis footwear is required (non-marking soles).

 If playing before 9:00 AM, we ask that you please use the upper courts by the pool area.
- 23. The club will permit <u>birthday parties</u> Monday Friday between the hours of 12:00 PM and 6:00 PM (<u>no</u> weekends). Parties MUST be approved by the Village 2 office. Each guest must be a member of the club or pay the guest fee (when permitted), and there is a maximum of twenty (20) guests per party, with guests allowed only during the time of party.
- 24. Persons using any of our club facilities do so at their own risk. The club is not responsible for any injury, accident, or theft resulting from such use.
- 25. Pets are not permitted to enter the complex with members / guests, with the exception of official "service" pets. Emotional support pets are not permitted.
- 26. All members and / or guests are required to adhere to all printed and posted safety regulations or those set by the management and lifeguards which may be put into place as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic.

Please be aware that:

- The lifeguards have final and complete authority. Any disagreement with his/her judgment should be presented to the lifeguard and/or pool management at a later date or in writing and not discussed with the lifeguard while on duty.
- The lifeguards have the authority to terminate all pool privileges of any person for infractions, including guests.
- The pool building, including restrooms and locker room facilities, will be closed fifteen (15) minutes earlier than the pool complex each evening. Lifeguards will clear and lock the building at this time, and we ask for members' cooperation.

The following will be cause for immediate expulsion from the pool grounds:

- · Willfully disobeying any order from a lifeguard / staff member or posted regulation
- Any minor using alcoholic beverages or drugs
- · Any adult using drugs or consuming excessive alcoholic beverages
- · Improper behavior / language that infringes upon the rights of others
- Unsafe actions that endanger yourself or others
- Any behavior that is willfully offensive to others
- Any damage or willful destruction of club property or property belonging to others
- Possession of glass

It is very important to ensure the safety of all members, guests and staff while operating the pool complex and facilities, therefore, we ask for the complete cooperation of all members and their guests. These rules and regulations will benefit all who use the pools / tennis facilities only if every member cooperates. It is our hope that all members enjoy their time at the pool complex and believe that this is easily accomplished with awareness and the enforcement of the noted regulations.

** Once again, failure to adhere to all Village 2 Club regulations may result in the immediate revocation of membership.
